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Aroma	Intense. Can smell with glass at shoulder level.				Light. Can only smell with nose in glass.

PINOT GRIGIO

Often light, crisp, and dry with plenty of zippy, mouth-watering acidity.
You are likely to taste a sweet, if not semi-sweet taste. Most are fresh and fruity.

ROSÉ

Rosé happens when the skins of red grapes touch wine for only a short time. It tastes like fruit and flowers—lighter than your average wine.

Color	Solid pale pink to a light red No hints of yellow/brown		
Taste	Red fruits, flowers, melon Dry, fresh, usually acidic		
Finish	Crunchy green flavor like celery or rhubarb

CABERNET

Typically viewed as a fairly robust wine with good tannin structure, solid acidity, and rich, dark fruit aromas/flavor components.

Taste	Dry, full/medium bodied Dark, rich, complex
